



In 2024, the Pinal County Medical Examiner's Office began hosting monthly death investigation seminars, free of charge, for our law enforcement and medical center partners. The seminars cover a wide range of medicolegal topics and are designed to expand participants' knowledge of injury and wound patterns of various types, the pathophysiology of injuries, and best practices for preserving evidence on the body of a deceased subject. Participants also have the opportunity to view a postmortem examination (autopsy) immediately following the lecture portion of the seminar. Following the success of the monthly seminars in 2025, we are proud to announce that the PCMEO will continue to provide monthly lectures throughout 2026.
